Project: Railway Station

Arrival signage Improve wayfinding and arrival signage creating a clear link to Chapel

Street and destinations beyond.

Freccles proposal Implement basic changes proposed by Freccles for the tidying of

parking areas. Ensure material selection chosen uses a similar range

of furniture as found in the town centre and Church Street.

Plaza upgrade Investigate, with the intention of implementing, an improved scheme

creating a complete pedestrian friendly plaza and a real sense of

arrival.

Description

Project: Heritage Quarter

Remove clutter on Church Street

Remove benches, apart from one, and accompanying bins from top end of Church Street from the junction with John William Street to the

railway station. Provide new keys for drop down bollard.

Station Approach

Create a pedestrian approach to the railway station connecting the

railway station with the pedestrianised Church Street.

Church Road Improvements.

Provide a shared surface along Church Road to slow traffic down and

provide a high quality environment.

John William Street gateway Extend quality treatment found on Church Road along John William

Street to create a sense of arrival to Eccles' high street.

Cross Keys Introduce a high quality treatment to the area outside the Cross Keys

pub. The area could potentially perform an outdoor room for events

and fairs.



Project: Alleys and grot spots

Alleyways

Clean

Remove weeds and clean alleys.

Re-surface

Create a level bitmac surface to allow level access along alleyways.

Organise bin storage

Introduce bin storage for the organised storage of bins. Using a discreet material to screen and control the management of waste.

Land adjacent to Dog and Partridge

Beautify

Re-paint knee rails and prepare designs to create a usable space.

Introduce colour and planting.

Project: Albert Street Junction with Wellington Road

Maintenance Remove shrub planting and replace with grassed areas that

incorporate densely planted seasonal bulbs to add colour and

vibrancy.

Crossings Understand where informal crossing points are and incorporate paths

through.

Tree boulevard Plant trees more regularly to create a boulevard.

Project: Albert Street Arrival, Gateway Improvements

Traffic signs Remove as many one way signs as legally possible, replace all

remaining faded signs and upgrade keep left bollard to rebound

signmaster.

Reducing posts for

signage

Combine one way sign with other piece of street furniture to remove

posts.

Creating a gateway Remove the insignificant welcome sign and replace with a larger piece

of public art and planting that signifies entry into Eccles.

Reduce road width Narrow Albert Street to one lane, to allow the removal of pedestrian

barriers resulting from slower speeds.





Project: Vicar's Walk, Gateway Improvements

Maintenance Replace damaged furniture including guard rails and street name

plate, remove graffiti.

Wayfinding Introduce wayfinding fingerposts.

Better views Cut back trees to reveal views to church tower.

A gateway Prepare designs to create a more prominent gateway.

Project: Liverpool Road, Gateway Improvements

Damaged signage Remove damaged 'Dual Carriageway Ahead' sign.

Clear litter Ensure litter hotspots in this area are regularly cleared.

Screen gap site Provide a screen to the former Tesco site, incorporating artwork to

make the corner more attractive.

Project: Bentcliffe Way, Gateway Improvements

Maintenance

Cut back all hedges from south side of pedestrian footpath. Agree maintenance regime for the street.

Pedestrian crossing Improve pedestrian crossing facilities at roundabout.

Project: Pedestrian and cycle links to West One

Maintenance (short term)

Cut back overgrown planting and crown lift trees to open up better

surveillance to the pathways.

Maintenance (long term)

Agree improved maintenance regime for the area.

Wayfinding

Introduce new clearer wayfinding markers.







Project: Regent Street

Boundaries

Environmental improvements to left over spaces on Regent Street. Knee rails and boundary treatments to edge of sites. Remove weeds. Assess possibility of introducing permeable surfacing i.e. grasscrete to areas of car parking.

Highway

Liaise with appropriate authority to repair damaged

highway.

Project: Overall improvements (Maintenance)

Tree Guards

Remove all tree guards from established trees.

Dead trees

Replace 3 x street trees that have died (Southway, outside old Town Hall). Rectify issues with trees on

these sites.

Replace furniture

Replace damaged furniture and remove obsolete

furniture.

Paint Green

Re-paint all furniture and lamposts, where faded, that

should be painted green.

Maintenance

Organise and liaise with maintenance teams to ensure that: bins are emptied regularly; planting is properly pruned; furniture is fit for purpose; and highways and footpaths are repaired where necessary.
