Confirm that, in exercise of the powers conferred on it in accordance with the Scheme of Delegation of the Council, the Cabinet have approved the Area Plans following community consultation on the basis of the text submitted to Cabinet, but incorporating the amendments to the text for Worsley and Boothstown recommended by Councillors Warner, Merry and Warmisham.

The Reasons are the Area Plans have been subject to an extensive consultation process. Cabinet believes that the reference to the Greenbelt in the Worsley and Boothstown Area Plan should recognise that it represents an asset for both the City and the local area, and that this needs to be at the heart of the Tourism Strategy. In view of the scale and the nature of the planning application, the Salford Forest Park proposal should be referred to in neutral terms and without prejudice to the decision of the Planning Panel. The educational allocation at Boothstown should be retained for the meantime, pending the outcome of the primary schools review.

Options considered and rejected were:-

- No reference to the wider importance to the City of the Green Belt
- No reference to the Salford Forest Park proposal
- Retention of the educational allocation at Boothstown for the foreseeable future.
