## a) SHIELD DRIVE, SWINTON

A request has been received from Wilkinson Star, Wardley Industrial Estate for the introduction No Waiting at Any Time at the loading entrance to their unit. A problem exists when heavy goods vehicles are parked close to their entrance causing visibility problems and manoeuvres. Further problems are being experienced at the junction of Shield Drive with vehicles parking on the junction.

A site investigation was conducted and concluded that there is sufficient scope to introduce waiting restrictions without compromising parking facilities for other units within this location. It is therefore intended to introduce No Waiting at Any Time for a distance of 15m both sides of Wilkinson Star entrance and 15m in both direction at Shield Drive Junction.

Emergency services have no objections to the proposals.



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

## b) HODSON STREET, SALFORD

A complaint has been received from the Stay Inn Hotel regarding double parking on Hodson Street. It is claimed all day parking hinders access to the hotel for larger vehicles.
