This includes Greater Manchester Police, Salford city council, the university of Salford, the education and health authorities, the community and voluntary sector and many other bodies. All of the organisations involved have committed to making sure that you will start to benefit from many of these improvements within the next three years.

This leaflet tells you what we intend to do over the next ten years, and what the city will be like in 2016. There are also some suggestions on how you can help to make Salford a great place to live, work and relax. This is a summary of our plans.
