## Salford City Council - Record of Decision

I, Cllr John Warmisham, Lead Member for Children's Services, in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph J(a)(i) authorise the re-location of Salford Youth Offending Service (YOS) from Encombe Place to St Simon Street, Salford, and the expenditure of £155,000 as a contribution to the costs of refurbishment and extension to the premises at St Simon Street. This contribution will be met from balances within the YOS budget.

## The Reasons are that:

- The YOS is currently accommodated in premises that are unfit for purpose and that cannot be made DDA compliant.
- 2. The St Simon St. premises can be adapted, within the budget available, to meet the requirements of the YOS.
