

SALFORD CITY COUNCIL - RECORD OF DECISION

I Councillor CWV HINDS in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Paragraph G(7)(f)(ii) of the Scheme of Delegation of the Council do hereby authorise the provision of an Essential User Car Allowance to the Cultural Partnership Manager in the Cultural Services Division of the Community, Health and Social Care Directorate.

The reasons are that this was specified in the advertisement [see attached] for the post but not in the documents submitted to Payroll.

The city/region wide duties of this post make an Essential User Allowance necessary and all the other three senior managers in the Cultural Services Team are allocated Essential Allowances [see attached].

An option considered and rejected was to pay the officer an extra increment in lieu of the advertised allowance – this was considered inappropriate.
