Further to my recent letter to you, in which I advised you of our proposal to close the above branch, I am writing to let you know the final decision.

We have received a number of comments from customers and local representatives during the consultation period. Concerns centred mainly on the effect of the closure on the more elderly customers within the local community and the convenience of nearby alternative branches.

We believe the area to be well served by local Post Office branches. Indeed, there are a number of branches near to the above closing branch, as detailed below.

While we fully appreciate using a different branch a little further away will be a major change for some, we have carefully considered both the local terrain and the facilities available within the area, particularly parking and public transport, in arriving at our final decision. In addition to this, a member of our network team has personally visited the area and 'walked the ground', with a view to ensuring that all aspects of customer accessibility have, as far as possible, been taken into account.

It might be helpful at this stage to explain our main criterion for access to our network, which is that we aim to ensure that, even after the Network Reinvention programme is implemented, 95% of our customers live within a mile of their nearest Post Office branch, with the majority residing within half a mile. Currently, 96% of our customers nationally live within a mile of their nearest Post Office branch, with the majority of these residing within half a mile.

We have carefully considered our original proposal and taking into account the overall branch resources in the area, we have decided that permanent closure of the above branch is the correct action to take.

As a result, this branch will close permanently on 23 July 2003.

As indicated earlier, we remain satisfied that there are a number of alternative branches nearby that are suitably located and offer the right services to meet the needs of the local community. Details of alternative branch opening hours, transport, disabled access and routes are given below.
