- entering into the Lancashire Procurement Hub agreement on behalf of the Environment Directorate (Citywide Services) and Community Health & Social Care with G4S Cash Services (UK) Ltd for the period 1 August 2010 to 31 March 2011 (with the option to extend to 31 March 2013).
- authorise the City Solicitor to prepare contract award/agreement documents as soon as possible;
- authorise delegated authority to the Strategic Director of Customer and Support Services or his appointed representative to negotiate an optional 24 month extension (reviewed annually) to the contract dependent on satisfactory service provision, consistent quality of product and maintenance of competitive unit costs.

The Reasons are – To ensure the provision of Cash in Transit services and that delivery of such services will be carried out in a safe and cost effective manner. Approval to enter into contract with G4S Cash Services (UK) Ltd, under the agreement introduced by Lancashire Procurement Hub and managed by Burnley BC, representing the best overall value for the authority from a company whose quality of service has been assured.
