Approve that the contract for the supply of electricity to all Public Lighting within the boundaries of Salford City Council, be awarded to the lowest tenderer. The contract will commence 1 April 2011 for a two year period.

The Reasons are following a sealed bid tender process tenderer 1 submitted a 12 month and 24 month contract. The 24 month will result in a cost of £1,388,942. This amounts to an increase in the annual costs of £219,738 (18.79%). An invitation to tender was placed via an OJEU notice and only one document was returned.

Options considered and rejected were a 12 month contract was considered, however, whilst this would have limited the increase in costs to 16.29%, energy prices are quite volatile and it is anticipated that in the present economic climate, electricity prices will increase by more than 2.5% over the next 12 months. A 24 month contract would be the best option.
