I, Councillor Joseph Murphy, Lead Member for Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Paragraph by Part 4 Section 7 Paragraph 2 , 2.1 (a), of the Scheme of Delegation of the Council do hereby approve the placing of an order to purchase grounds maintenance equipment with Balmers, Turner Goundcare, All Seasons and Sharrock to the value of £164,574.

The Reasons are to improve efficiencies within the operational service area.

Options considered and rejected were. Continue with annual hire arrangement

Assessment of Risk. Through OJEU procurement exercise

The source of funding is service revenue account.

Legal Advice obtained. Central procurement; full OJEU tender exercise

Financial Advice obtained. Directorate Group Accountant; decision realises a five year saving of £471,471
