

Salford City Council - Record of Decision

I, Councillor Antrobus, Lead Member for Planning, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section H, Paragraph a) Engineering Service (sub-paragraph vii), and Section J, Paragraph a) (i), of the Scheme of Delegation of the Council do hereby:

1. Approve the junction improvements at Regent Road/Oldfield Road, Broad Street/Albion Way/The Crescent and Liverpool Street/Albion Way as outlined in this report, which collectively comprise the "Chapel Street Highway and Public Realm Improvements – Enabling Works" ;
2. Accept the lowest compliant tender, which is from Urban Vision Highway Services, for the "Chapel Street Highway and Public Realm Improvements – Enabling Works"; and
3. Note the intention to commence work on site in February 2010, subject to North West Regional Development Agency funding approval.

The Reasons are to enable to works to commence promptly and ensure the expenditure of North West Development Agency funding allocations for the current financial year.

Assessment of Risk Medium: There is a risk if a decision is delayed that North West Development Agency funding for this financial year may not be expended resulting in a budget shortfall for the project.

The source of funding is North West Development Agency through a grant funding agreement with Salford City Council.
